





Foreword

Foreign aid continues to play a significant role in supporting socio-economic development of Nepal. The Government of Nepal primarily receives grants and loan assistances. Under the grants, some Technical Assistances (TA) are also received from the various Development Partners (DPs) for institutional strengthening, capacity development, human resource development, provisions of services of experts and consultants, transfer of technical know-how and skills and preperation and development of projects and programs. The Government of Nepal is committed towards realizing maximum achievements by mobilizing the TA in line with the country's development needs and priorities.

Apart from bilateral and multilateral development partners, the development assistance channeled through various International Non-Governmental Organizations (INGOs) also constitutes a significant share of foreign aid in Nepal. Various INGOs are implementing programs in partnership with Government agencies, local bodies or the local NGOs and also through active community participation by empowering and making aware the poor, excluded and marginalized people.

Amid concerns raised by various quarters of the society about the mobilization of both grants and loans including TA in general and effectiveness in particular, and as part of own efforts to streamline inflows of foreign aid with the country system, the Government remains committed to make foreign aid related data and other transactions fully transparent. In addition, the Government has been continuously reorienting its efforts to ensure compliance of foreign aid mobilization with the aid effectiveness principles.

This statement contains a summary description of projects and programs being implemented in the country supported from the Development Partners which are not reflected in the Annual Income and Expenditure Estimates (Red Book) of the Government. Furthermore, during the preparation of this book, Aid Management Platform (AMP) a database of the International Economic Cooperration Coordination Division of the Ministry of Finance, and data received from both development partners and sectoral ministries have also been used as the primary sources of information. In addition, this book also contains a brief description of the programs being impemented and resources channeled through INGOs for the Fiscal Year 2012/13.

I believe that this publication will be useful to Government agencies and DPs to monitor the TA programme, and to all other intellectuals, professionals, economists, researchers, scholars, teachers, students, and other interested individuals for their use.
