



Preface

Development cooperation has been playing a significant role in the socio-economic development of Nepal. The Government of Nepal is always effortful in making all kinds of development cooperation fully transparent. The development cooperation that is mobilized on budget is reflected in the Annual Income and Expenditure Estimates (Red Book) of the Government. Those projects/programs which are not covered in the national budget are to be presented in the form of the Statements of Technical and Other Assistance. Accordingly, the summary details of those projects/programs not reflected in the national budget, with the support from bi-lateral and multilateral agencies, and INGOs, are presented in this publication.

For the last few years, the volume of development cooperation mobilized through International Non-governmental Organisation (INGOs) has been increasing. The aid mobilized through INGOs during fiscal year 2013/14 was reflected for the first time in the Development Cooperation Report. Efforts have been made to continue publishing such information. Overall management of technical assistance is a challenging task. The dissemination of information through this publication is a step forward to ensure transparency in all types of aid coming to Nepal.

The present report reflects projects/programs related to technical and other assistance which are not covered in the budget, their major activities, total and annual budget and donor's country including project/program and districts under implementation. The primary sources of information on Technical Assistance have been the Aid Management Platform (AMP) of the International Economic Cooperation Coordination Division of the Ministry of Finance and the information received from both DPs and sectoral ministries. Likewise, for the programs implemented through INGOs, the information received from Social Welfare Council has also been used as the primary source.

I believe that this publication will be useful to Government agencies and DPs to implement and monitor the off-budget programs, and to all other professionals, economists, researchers, teachers, students, and other individuals interested in foreign aid mobilization in Nepal.
